Young Woman of Tomorrow Nomination Criteria

Young Woman of Distinction Award Objective:

To recognize a young woman, currently in high school, college or advanced training, under the age of 25, whose demeanor and accomplishments suggest great promise for the future. Her academic, extracurricular, and/or personal achievements are exemplary for her peers and her community.

To further emphasize the leadership of award recipients, the Women and Girls Fund, in collaboration with honorees, will award a \$1,000 grant to a Waukesha County nonprofit organization in the name of the honoree.

Award Criteria

The nominee must:

- Demonstrate qualities of responsibility, dependability and motivation, which distinguish her from her peers.
- Demonstrate outstanding qualities of leadership and have great promise for the future.
- Be currently enrolled in high school, college or advanced training.
- Be under the age of 25 years.
- Have a record of accomplishment unusual and outstanding for someone her age.
- Be willing to be interviewed by media representatives and photographed for the luncheon program and media releases.
- Attend an evening reception on Monday, May 10, and accept her award at the luncheon on Tuesday, May 11, 2010.

How to Nominate

Submit the following information to the Waukesha County Community Foundation office by Friday, January 29, 2010:

- Completed and signed nomination form with verification that the nominee meets the nomination criteria and is willing and able to attend the Women of Distinction events outlined in the Award Criteria.
- A personal evaluation to indicate how your nominee meets criteria for the Young Woman of Tomorrow Award.
- A brief resume or other biographical information.
- Additional letters of recommendation (3 maximum); other supporting material (3 maximum).

Judging

1. Information provided will be the sole basis of evaluation by the judges.
2. If your nominee is not selected for this award, she will receive a Special Recognition Honor.
3. Prior nominees may be re-nominated.
